Dear Mr. McAnany:

Enclosed for filing is one copy of Upper Peninsula Telephone Company's revisions to M.P.S.C. Tariff No. 1R pursuant to PA 179 of 1991, as amended, MCL 484.2101 et seq. under TAM Transmittal No. 4. This tariff filing does the following:

- 1. Revises the title of the tariff from "Primary Basic Local Exchange Service" to "Basic Local Exchange Service"; and revises tariff sheets which used the term "Primary Basic Local Exchange Service" in the header or text of the tariff;
- 2. Eliminates the offering of Primary Basic Local Exchange Service to customers, which service is no longer required under Michigan law;
- 3. Eliminates the tariff sheets for the former exchanges of Amble, Chester, Grace Harbor and Manistee River which are located in the Lower Peninsula and are now served by Michigan Central Broadband Company, an affiliate of Upper Peninsula Telephone Company;
- 4. Eliminates the obsolete tariff provisions for Lifeline Service. The rates, terms and conditions of Lifeline Service now offered by the Company are set forth in TAM M.P.S.C. Tariff No. 9R in which the Company is a concurring carrier;
- 5. Increases the Establishment of Service, Line Connection and Premise Visit Charges and revises the conditions under which such charges apply;
- 6. Adds an NSF check charge;
- 7. Adds and revises tariff provisions for the rates, terms and conditions for Local Calling Service Plan 1 (which was formerly called Local Calling Service Plan U1) found in Tariff M.P.S.C. No 3U which tariff is being rescinded.

# LOCAL TELEPHONE EXCHANGE SERVICE SERVICE CHARGES

#### A. GENERAL

- 1. Service charges are applicable with the establishment of telephone service and for subsequent moves thereto as specified in the tariff.
- 2. Service charges consisting of one or more of the following charges apply for new service which requires the activity or work as briefly indicated under "Charges" or as specified under the Application of Charges or as modified by specific tariff items elsewhere in the tariff.

#### B. APPLICATION OF CHARGES

Establishment of Service - An establishment of service charge applies on each customer order when a
new customer account is established. A customer order involving changes or addition to an existing
account (made subsequent to establishment of the account) also has an establishment of service charge
as shown under "Charges."

The establishment of service charge also applies to restoral of service temporarily disconnected for nonpayment.

Line Connection Charge - A line connection charge is made for each line on which work is required
by the service order which does not involve dispatching a truck to the customer's premise.
Included is restoral of service temporarily disconnected for nonpayment.

3. Premise Visit - A charge applies to each customer's order which requires a premise visit. This charge applies per premise or same continuous property of the customer. Service work in several buildings of a customer located on the same continuous property requires one premise visit charge.

#### **DESCRIPTION OF SERVICE**

#### A. General. (M)

- 1. Local Calling Service Plan 1 provides telephone intercommunication between customers within a Local Calling Area.
- 2. Unless otherwise indicated, the service may be used for voice or data communication. The service provides unlimited incoming local calls.
- 3. In addition to the Monthly Local Service Charge, for calls dialed to a station bearing the designation of a central office within an exchange in the Local Calling Area, the Company reserves the right to will charge the following:

First 2,000 Conversation minutes of use (MOU) in each month: \$0.00 per MOU Each Conversation MOU over 2,000 in each month: \$0.05 per MOU

The Company will measure Conversation MOU from the time when the Company's switching equipment receives answer supervision to the earlier of when the Company's switch receives disconnection supervision from its own switch or from the terminating switch. The Company will measure Conversation MOU to the next higher whole MOU per call. No MOU are carried forward from month to month.

- 4. The Company will not provide call record detail for local usage in the end user's monthly bill. The Company will provide call record detail, at the end user's request, at a charge of \$5.00 for each month requested.
- 5. For calls to exchanges not in the Local Calling Area, customers will be billed long distance charges.
- 6. Touch Tone Service is included with this service.
- 7. Service Charges as stated in this tariff apply.
